

Dear Instructor,

At the ITF Extraordinary Congress Meeting in Vienna on July 1st it was, unfortunately, necessary to expel former Master Lim Won Sup. Lim Won Sup had exceeded his authority as Under Secretary General of the ITF by attempting to negotiate terms with the WTF for the ITF/WTF merger. This authority rests with the chairman and members of the Merger Committee and nobody else is allowed to conduct negotiations.

Lim Won Sup also communicated ITF policy to the WTF and thereby put us at a disadvantage in our future negotiations. He was therefore expelled under article 78. 6) of the ITF Constitution following his unsatisfactory explanation to the ITF Disciplinary Committee about his conduct. He made allegations that the ITF was under the control of North Korea but we believe that this is "sour grapes" owing to his disappointment at not being elected Secretary General of the ITF at the December Congress.

Lim is no longer a member of the ITF and has no right to claim that he is. He has contacted members of the UKTA and may contact more. Although you may have some sympathy for him please do not promise to help until you have spoken to a UKTA official about it. Lim has forfeited his position as a Master with us and do not let him try to force his authority upon you.
