SUBJECT: Extraordinary Congress Meeting

Dear Members,

Some decisions were made at the congress meeting in Rimini and at that time it was thought that it would be the best way to proceed for the future. Upon reflection, particularly in respect of the activities of a small group of people who are creating a major chaos within ITF in anticipation of the change in leadership, they have made the proper administration of ITF practically impossible. It is the general opinion that the format chosen in Rimini is not suitable and we should reconsider the normal 6 year term.

It looks ever more likely that there will be a merger between ITF and WTF and if it is a fact that Gen. Choi will be replaced in a given time period then there will be reluctance on the part of the WTF to negotiate. Gen. Choi must have a senior position in the Executive with special powers to pursue the merger between ITF and WTF.

To this end I feel that it is necessary to call for an Extraordinary Congress meeting in order to explain the strategy to all the members and receive their decision about what is the best way forward. My proposal is that there will be an Extraordinary Congress meeting held in Vienna on one of the days between 11<sup>th</sup>. To 13<sup>th</sup>. January 2002. The agenda for this meeting will be sent later. At that time there will be a "Masters Seminar" conducted by myself for all 6 Dan and above who are Presidents of the national associations. There will be a small fee of US\$100.00 to cover costs and a special certificate will be given. It is my belief that there will also be an AETF meeting at that time and therefore we are combining all items to save costs.

I am asking for your support at this critical time for the ITF.
