

A BRIEF HISTORY OF GRAND MASTER KIM BOK MAN 9TH DAN

Master Kim Bok Man is one of the most senior Taekwon-Do Masters he was on the very first Taekwon-Do Demonstration Team to perform outside of Korea in 1959, when with General Choi Hong Hi and other prominent pioneer masters i.e. Grand Masters Nam Tae Hi, Han Cha Hyo, Cha Soo Young, Woo Jae Lim, Ko Jae Chun and Baek Joon Gi. He went on a tour of the Far East, i.e. Vietnam, Taiwan etc. He later went on to teach in Singapore in 1963 where he was Chief Instructor before moving to Hong Kong in 1966, where he started the Hong Kong Taekwon-Do Association and was its Chief Instructor, he was also instrumental in organising and participating in many Demonstrations in Asia, where he was to become Chief Instructor performing before many Presidents and Heads of State, he also played host to the Annual Asian Taekwon-Do Championships.

He is also the author of many magazine articles and has also had a Book Practical Taekwon-Do printed. In 1987 Master Kim moved from Hong Kong to Denver, Colorado, U.S.A. where he now teaches and resides.
