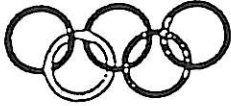

Der Mr. Rivera,

Thank you for your letter of 25th August 1983.


Further to your request, may I inform you that when the IOC granted its recognition to the WTF there was no indication of the existence of the ITF which also governs taekwondo internationally.

However, after the WTF was recognised, an application for recognition was received from the ITF.

Taking into consideration that the IOC only recognises those sports governed by one IF, the IOC decided to encourage the WTF and the ITF to merge. In fact, taekwondo unification is likely to be the sole step to be taken in order to ensure an equal opportunity for those who practise your sport, in spite of their affiliation to one or other IF.

I trust that this is satisfactory to you.
