Dear Members,

You will, no doubt, have received a letter from Park Jung Tae dated 16th. March, 1990 in which he says that he is explaining his situation. We feel that an answer must be given to that letter, although we find it unpleasant to do so.

Park Jung Tae was given every opportunity to carry out his duties properly but he chose to conduct a personal vendetta against our president. He was also found to have misused ITF funds. His allegation that he did not resign from the position of secretary general is simply a technicality as he was advised that his failure to carry out his duties would mean that it would be considered that he had resigned.

For many years Park Jung Tae was an avid admirer of, and very much in support of North Korea. His promises to help North Korea were rewarded when they presented him with the Distinguished Service Medal. Having been awarded this medal he must have thought that it gave him a very favoured and trusted position because he then proceeded to do something which is very hard to believe. Park Jung Tae and Han Sam Soo visited North Korea and asked the officers of the North Korea TKD Federation to remove our President, Gen. Choi Hong Hi, from the office of president of the ITF.

The character and intentions of Park Jung Tae can be seen through his letter where he tells you that **he has formed a new organization**, invites you to join it, then signs the letter as president. We are left wondering about the democracy of **his organization?**
